1.5 CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS:

The Championship is scheduled to be contested over six Meetings as follows:

The format for each weekend will usually be Qualifying and Race 1 on the first day with two races on the second day. The grid for race one will be set from the qualifying session, the grid for race 2 will be set from the lap times set in race 1 and the grid for race 3 will be set from the finishing positions in race 2, in each case following the conclusion of all judicial matters. At single day meetings the format will be single qualifying and 2 races with the grid for race 1 determined by fastest qualifying times and the grid for race 2 from the results of race subject to conclusion of all judicial matters. In order to provide for those drivers who share cars where a second driver may qualify (in or out of session) and be the competitor in either race 2 or race 3 then at the discretion of the designated clerk of the course that second starting competitor maybe permitted to take the race start from the grid position that would have been allocated to the driver from the preceding race.
